**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE BID FROM BURGESS AMBULANCE SALES INC
FOR A 2017 MCCOY MILLER AMBULANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2017, bids were received for an ambulance for New Lexington Emergency Medical Services

WHEREAS, Burgess Ambulance Sales, Inc. submitted the best bid for an ambulance to meet the needs of New Lexington Emergency Medical Services and the New Lexington Fire Department has recommended the award of the contract to Burgess Ambulance Sales, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio as follows:


Section 1: The ambulance contract for New Lexington Emergency Medical Services is hereby awarded to Burgess Ambulance Sales, Inc. for having submitted the best bid.


Section 2: The Village Administrator is authorized to execute a contract with Burgess Ambulance Sales, Inc. for a 2017 McCoy Miller Ambulance.

Section 3: That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the Village of New Lexington for the reason that the purchase of the ambulance is necessary in order to protect the health of the inhabitants of the Village by providing adequate Emergency Medical Services and shall, therefore, go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to this Council; otherwise, it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote of Council and upon approval by the Mayor.


