THE VILLAGE OF NEW LEXINGTON

TIMOTHY J. ROSS

AND DECLARING IT AND EMERGENCY

This employment contract is made this <u>lo</u> day of the month of <u>September</u> 2021, between the Village of New Lexington Perry County Ohio, hereafter referred to as the Village and Timothy J. Ross, hereafter referred to as Chief of Police.

WHEREAS: The Village and the Chief of Police wish to set forth the terms and conditions upon which the Village employ the Police Chief; and

WHEREAS: The parties wish to memorialize their intent within this agreement and indent that this agreement represents the parties entire understanding of the terms and conditions of the Village Chief of Police employment.

NOW THEREFORE: The Village and the Chief of Police in consideration of their mutual covenants contained herein, and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged by the parties, and agree as follows:

Section 1: TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT

- A. The Village hereby employs the Village Chief of Police and the Village Chief of Police hereby accepts employment with the Village, upon the terms set forth in this agreement, effective as of the date hereof (the effective date). The Village Chief of Police shall perform such services consistent with the Chief of Police position. The Chief of Police may be required to work a flexible schedule and work times other than normal business hours.
- B. The Village shall waive any and all residency requirements contained in the Ohio Revised Code, Village Charter and the Village Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual.

C. Dispatch/Police Employee Mariah Ross will not be supervised in any way shape or form by the Village Chief of Police. All Supervision For Mariah Ross will be handled by the Village Administrator and/or Mayor.

Section 2: The Village of New Lexington shall pay the Chief of Police a base annual salary of Fifty Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00). Salary amount will be reevaluated one year from the date of this contract.

Section 3: The Chief of Police shall receive the same benefit package as provided to all other full time employee's subject to the terms and conditions of the Personnel Policy and Procedure Manual and the Village Charter.

Section 4: All previous Pay Resolutions and Ordinances for the Village Chief of Police Position before said date become null and void.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date provided by law.
