Resolution 21-29

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CONTRACT OF ERIC EMMERT AS NEW LEXINGTON VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND **DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the New Lexington Village Council has determined that there exists a need to amend the terms and conditions upon which the Village employed Eric Emmert as the Village Administrator,

WHEREAS, Eric Emmert was hired with a salary of fifty-two thousand dollars (\$52,000) with a review of the salary after his six months' probation which ends January 6, 2022, and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council acknowledges that Eric Emmert's probation will be completed successfully and therefore wants to increase Eric Emmert's annual salary by six thousand dollars (\$6,000), and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Ohio as follows:

SECTION 1: The Village of New Lexington hereby approves to increase Eric Emmert salary for the Village Administrator position effective January 2, 2022 to fifty-eight thousand dollars (\$58,000).

SECTION 2: All other terms hereby ratified, confirmed and remain unchanged except as stated herein.

SECTION 3: That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and the welfare of the residents of the Village of New Lexington and for the further reason that the immediate approval is necessary to expedite training of the Village Administrator, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to the Council of the Village of New Lexington; otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote or the Council of the Village of New Lexington.
