## Resolution 21-30

## A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CONTRACT OF TIMOTHY (TJ) ROSS AS NEW LEXINGTON POLICE CHIEF AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the New Lexington Village Council has determined that there exists a need to amend the terms and conditions upon which the Village employed Timothy J. Ross as the Police Chief,

WHEREAS, Timothy J. Ross was hired with a salary of fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000), and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council acknowledges that Timothy J. Ross salary is not in line with similar Police Chiefs in the area and therefore wants to increase his salary by three thousand dollars (\$3,000), and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Ohio as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The Village of New Lexington hereby approves to increase Timothy J. Ross salary for the Police Chief position effective January 2, 2022 to fifty-eight thousand dollars (\$58,000).

**SECTION 2:** All other terms hereby ratified, confirmed and remain unchanged except as stated herein.

**SECTION 3:** That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and the welfare of the residents of the Village of New Lexington and for the further reason that the immediate approval is necessary to expedite training of the Village Administrator, and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to the Council of the Village of New Lexington; otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote or the Council of the Village of New Lexington.
