

Resolution 21-31

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FINANCE DIRECTOR HEIDI MILNER TO APPLY FOR BROWNFIELD GRANTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Ohio Department of Development is accepting grant applications for brownfield assessment, remediation, and demolition, and

WHEREAS, New Lexington has potential sites that fit this category that are viable for economic development and recovery, and

WHEREAS, Mayor and Council acknowledges the need to apply for funding to clean up, remediate, and demolish certain brownfield sites in the Village of New Lexington, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Ohio as follows:


SECTION 1: Heidi Milner is authorized to submit any and all grant applications to secure funding for brownfield properties inside the Village of New Lexington.


SECTION 2: Mrs. Milner is further authorized to sign on behalf of the Village of New Lexington agreements, contracts, and leases necessary to comply with the requirements in the grant application.

SECTION 3: That it is hereby determined that this Resolution is an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and the welfare of the residents of the Village of New Lexington and shall therefore go into immediate effect provided it receives a two-thirds (2/3) vote of all members elected to the Council of the Village of New Lexington; otherwise it shall go into effect in thirty (30) days if passed by a majority vote or the Council of the Village of New Lexington.
