

RESOLUTION NO: 22-13

A RESOLUTION TO RESCIND RESOLUTION 22-6 AMENDING 21-9 THE RATES OF PAY FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES PERSONNEL, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

Whereas, the Council of the Village of New Lexington authorized pay raises for Fire Officers April 4, 2022 with Resolution 22-6; and EMS personnel with Resolution 21-9; and

Whereas, council deems it necessary to rescind Resolution 22-6 Section 3 for the Fire Department Officers' monthly compensation; and

Whereas, council deems this to be an emergency due to the financial stress the Fire Department is currently under; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio that Resolution 21-9 is affective and as follows:

Section 1: That as of July 4, 2021, EMS personnel will remain unchanged and paid as follows and continue the salary step plan:

Part time EMT Basic	\$ 12.00	Per Hour
Part time EMT Intermediate	\$ 13.00	Per Hour
Part time EMT Medic	\$ 14.00	Per Hour

Section 2: That the part time EMS personnel shall be paid at the rate of one and one-half times the employee's regular hourly rate of pay for the following holidays:

New Year's Day	Thanksgiving Day
Independence Day	Christmas Day

Section 3: That as of April 1, 2022, Fire personnel will be paid as follows:

Fire Chief:	\$250.00	Per Month plus compensation Per Run for qualified Fire runs
Assistant Fire Chief 1:	\$160.00	Per Month plus compensation Per Run for qualified Fire runs
Fireman	\$ 10.00	Per run after obtaining a current Valid fire card

Firemen will not be compensated for attendance at meetings

Section 4: That any and all ordinances and resolutions inconsistent with this resolution are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this resolution.

Section 5: That this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure for the preservation of the public, peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of New Lexington and shall take effect immediately upon passage or at the earliest period allowed by law.


