## **ORDINANCE NO. 22-6**

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR AND FINANCE DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE AN EASEMENT FROM THE SOUTHERN PERRY COUNTY WATER DISTRICT, OHIO, GRANTING A PERPETUAL EASEMENT REAL PROPERTY PARCEL 24009027000, AN OHIO NON-PROFIT CORPORATION, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONSTRUCTING AND MAINTAINING WATER LINES FOR \$1.00 AND OTHER VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Southern Perry County Water District desires to obtain a perpetual easement consisting of 20 feet of real property located on parcel 2400902700 from the City of New Lexington, Ohio, on 9246 Township Rd 262 to erect, construct, install and lay, maintain, replace and remove pipeline and all appurtenances for the transportation of water; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Lexington, Ohio is willing to grant the perpetual easement in said property for \$1.00 and other valuable consideration; and

WHEREAS, Southern Perry County Water needs the property for right-of-way purposes for the construction of the water line connection; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of New Lexington, Perry County, Ohio, at least three-fourths (3/4) of all members elected thereto:

SECTION 1. That Council does hereby authorize the City Administrator and Finance Director to execute the agreement for the City of New Lexington to grant a perpetual easement consisting of 20 feet of real property to Southern Perry County Water District for \$1.00 and other valuable consideration for the purpose of building and maintaining water lines, in substantial conformity with the terms of the Easement Agreement marked as Exhibit "1", attached hereto and incorporated herein.

SECTION 2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council, and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the residents of this City, for which reason and other reasons manifest to this Council this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force immediately after passage.
