

RESOLUTION NO. 23-21

A RESOLUTION OF THE Village of New Lexington ADOPTING THE Perry County 2023 Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan dated July 7, 2023

WHEREAS the Village of New Lexington recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within New Lexington; and

WHEREAS the Perry County Emergency Management Agency has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as Perry County 2023 Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan dated July 7, 2023 in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS Perry County 2023 Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan dated July 7, 2023, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in New Lexington from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by the Village of New Lexington demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Perry County 2023 Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan dated July 7, 2023.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Village of New Lexington, OHIO, THAT:

Section 1. In accordance with Ohio Revised Code, the Village of New Lexington adopts the Perry County 2023 Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan dated July 7, 2023. While content related to New Lexington may require revisions to meet the plan approval requirements, changes occurring after adoption will not require Village of New Lexington to re-adopt any further iterations of the plan. Subsequent plan updates following the approval period for this plan will require separate adoption resolutions.
