

RESOLUTION NO 24-2A

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT THE T-MOBILE HOMETOWN GRANT TO FUND IMPROVEMENTS AT MADISON PARK ON BROADWAY STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Whereas, T-Mobile is offering grant opportunities for communities of under 50,000 people for shovel-ready products; and

Whereas, the Village believes that making improvements at Madison Park qualifies for such grant; and

Whereas, the Village Council wishes to apply for said grant funding; and


Whereas, the Village Council wishes to authorize the Village Administrator to apply for and accept up to \$50,000 in grant funding for the purposes described in this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW LEXINGTON, PERRY COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1- The Village Administrator, or designee, is hereby authorized to apply for and accept the T-Mobile Hometown Grant in an amount up to \$50,000 to fund improvements of Madison Park on Broadway Street. The Village Administrator is authorized to do all things necessary or convenient to apply for and accept said funding and to carry out the terms of this Resolution, including the execution of documents required to obtain such funding.

Section 2- This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure as it is necessary to make an application for funding as early as possible to be considered and remain eligible for consideration by T-Mobile; this Resolution shall therefore take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor, and otherwise it shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
